

LAUDATO SI n°233

The universe unfolds in God, who fills it completely. Hence, there is a mystical meaning to be found in a leaf, in a mountain trail, in a dewdrop, in a poor person's face. (159)

The ideal is not only to pass from the exterior to the interior to discover the action of God in the soul, but also to discover God in all things. Saint Bonaventure teaches us that "contemplation deepens the more we feel the working of God's grace within our hearts, and the better we learn to encounter God in creatures outside ourselves". (160)



Footnote 159:

The Pope paraphrased a Muslim Mystique Alî al-Khawâs / Alî al-Hawwâs (d. 939/1532):

"Prejudice should not have us criticize those who seek ecstasy in music or poetry. There is a subtle mystery in each of the movements and sounds of this world. The initiate will capture what is being said when the wind blows, the trees sway, water flows, flies buzz, doors creak, birds sing, or in the sound of strings or flutes, the sighs of the sick, the groans of the afflicted..."

Muhammad and the protection of God's most precious creation

Kindness, care and good principles for the treatment of animals:

- ✓ Prohibited killing animals for sports, outlawed overloading donkeys and camels;
- ✓ Ordered killing animals for food should be done with kindness and consideration for their feelings and in respect of Allah – the giver and source of life.



Muhammad and the protection of God's most precious creation

- ✓ His camel guided him to the place where he built the first Mosque in Medina.
- ✓ 'The World is green and beautiful and God has appointed you his stewards over it.'



Muhammad and the protection of God's most precious creation

- ✓ "There is none among the believers
 who plants a tree, or sows a seed, and
 then a bird, or a person, or an animal
 eats of it, but it is counted as charity
 for them." (Bukhari)
- ✓ "Whoever plants a tree and diligently looks after it until it matures and bears fruit is rewarded." (Bukhari)



The root cause of the ecological crisis is corruption (fasād) or disruption

'Corruption has appeared on land and sea by what people's own hands have wrought, that He may let them taste some consequences of their deeds, So that they may turn back.' (30,41)

- Elaborated in 2009 in Istanbul
- Under the leadership of Yusuf al-Qaradawi, famous Muslim preacher
- Under the auspices of Muslim Associations for Climate Change Action (MACCA)
- Attended by 50 Muslim intellectuals and political leaders



THE MUSLIM SEVEN YEAR ACTION PLAN ON CLIMATE CHANGE 2010-2017

Main objective:

- ✓ Mobilization of the Umma : to promote healthy environment for their children and future generations where all nations of all religions could live in harmony with nature and enjoy justice and the blessings of God.
- ✓ Building green mosques, making green pilgrimages, develop environmental formation/education



THE MUSLIM SEVEN YEAR ACTION PLAN ON CLIMATE CHANGE 2010-2017

- ✓ Green mosques: Singapore (May 2009), Manchester (2008), Abu Dhabi, Djenne (Jenne);
- ✓ Making green pilgrimages: especially without plastic bags;
- ✓ Develop environmental formation/ education- Khutba (Zanzibar and Indonesia), Madrasas ...etc.



ISLAMIC DECLARATION ON CLIMATE CHANGE:

We call upon corporations, finance, and the business sector to... assist in the divestment from the fossil fuel driven economy and the scaling up of renewable energy and other ecological alternatives.



THE ISTANBUL DECLARATION 17 -18 August 2015

- At the initiative of Islamic Foundation for Ecology and Environmental Sciences (IFEES); The Islamic Relief Worldwide; Green Faith Inter-congregational Network
- Attended by 60 Muslims from 22 countries.





THE ISTANBUL DECLARATION 17 -18 August 2015

Affirmed:

- 1. Humans created for global services (Their Lord, all species, all individuals, all generations of God's creatures);
- Humans to maintain the equilibrium God has created;
- 3. Creation belongs to God;
- 4. Corruption (fasād) man made due to his unlimited appetite for acquisition, overproduction, exploitation of land and natural resources, overconsumption...;
- Need for alternative system: the world financial system;
- 6. All Muslims called to act change of mentality (conversion).
